Guidelines for Abstract Submission

1. Abstracts must be written exclusively in English.
2. Abstract must be limited to 300 words and must be concise and clear, highlighting the most relevant aspects, findings and conclusions. The word limit for the abstract title is 20.
3. Use only standard abbreviations. Special or unusual abbreviations are not recommended. If otherwise necessary, the latter should be placed in parenthesis after the first appearance of the full word, except for unit symbols. Numeral rather than words may be used to indicate numbers.
4. References are not required for abstract submission.
5. The abstract must contain original research material, not be published or presented at any other international congress
